Avon Middle School students Spring into Action for Easter Seals

Founded in 1919 in Elyria, Ohio, Easter Seals is the nation's oldest and largest nonprofit organization serving both children and adults with disabilities or other special needs. Easter Seals provides exceptional services to ensure that all people with disabilities or special needs and their families have equal opportunities to live, learn, work and play in their communities.

"This year AMS will be striving to raise money to send children with disabilities to summer camp," said Avon Middle School Principal, Dr. Craig Koehler. "The project begins on Tuesday, March 19 and runs through Wednesday, March 27. Office aides sell TULIPS for \$1.00 during lunch times.
