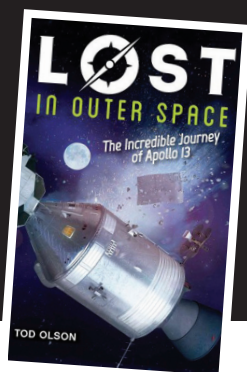




LOST IN OUTER SPACE
