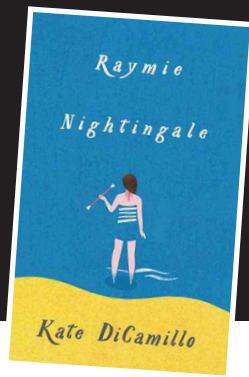




# RAYMIE NIGHTINGALE
