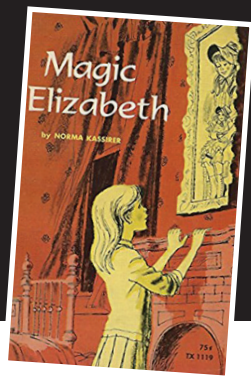




MAGIC ELIZABETH
